| HB 184 | KATZ | PUBLIC HEALTH Provides for the electronic filing of student immunization compliance reports for elementary and secondary schools |

HB 305	BADON, AUSTIN	SCHOOLS/LOCAL SUPERINTDT Removes exception for Orleans Parish relative to requirements that a local public school superintendent serve as the treasurer of certain school funds and perform specified duties related thereto
HB 306	BADON, AUSTIN	SCHOOLS/LOCAL SUPERINTDT Makes provisions relative to certain duties of a local public school superintendent, including but not limited to serving as school board secretary, applicable to Orleans Parish
HB 378	ARMES	SCHOOLS/EMPLOYEES Provides relative to noncomplex health procedures performed by certain school employees
HB 576	TRAHAN	SUNSET LAW Re-creates the Department of Education
HB 581	TRAHAN	STUDENTS Provides that chief administrators of schools responsible for ensuring the enforcement of immunization requirements by checking students' records must check such records annually
HB 672	TRAHAN	TEACHERS Changes the name of the list of teachers' rights from "Educators' Right to Teach" to "Teacher Bill of Rights" and provides relative to such rights
HB 719	CARMODY	SCHOOLS/EMPLOYEES Provides relative to in-service training for public school teachers, school counselors, principals, and certain other school administrators in suicide prevention
HB 1054	PETERSON	SCHOOLS/BOARDS Authorizes city, parish, and other local public school boards to create public benefit corporations
